



Youth In Transition - Human Trafficking supports youth that are at risk, currently involved in or are survivors of human trafficking and sex trades.

- Intensive case management
- Referrals and connections to supports and resources
- Education and resource supports
- Employment services & training
- Support specialized in Human Trafficking focusing on exiting strategies and continuous supports
- Street outreach focused on capacity building, empowerment, and culturally specific healing
- Services based in a harm reduction model that meets people where they are at in their journey and recognizes that all people walk their own paths
- Multi sector approach to care, services, referrals, advocacy and system navigation
- Access to cultural programming, teachings, and healing, Elders and Traditional Healers
- Self Esteem, Cultural Identity and Life skills program
- Assist with addictions and/or mental health issues and recovery support
