supports Indigenous Youth between the ages of 16-24 who are in a Voluntary Youth Services Agreement.

The Youth In Transition Housing Program

assists Indigenous Youth ages 16-17 in attaining housing.

YIT/H assists youth in navigating systems, creating community connections, and accessing independent housing.

- Housing supports
- Referrals

- Life skills training
- Health, mental health, and addictions services (navigation)
- Employment services & training
- Legal services - advocacy and court support
